Teacher Notes:

- Before students start the quiz, read aloud the introduction paragraph at the top of the page together. Remind students that they are not expected to know all of the answers.
- You may choose to correct the quizzes before or after the field trip.
 Many teachers like to collect the pre-trip quizzes and then have students try to correct them after their visit to the nature center.
- If you have very young students, complete the quiz as a class or in small groups. Talk about what some of the nature vocabulary words mean before your trip so that students are somewhat familiar with them when you arrive.
- You may extend this activity by having students generate other questions they have about farm life or nature. Have them write them on note cards. Collect the question cards, and take them with you to the nature center. Challenge students to find the answers to their questions during their field trip and write down the answer on the back of the card. If they cannot find the answer at the nature center, you may want to do some class research. Have students share what they learned with others.
